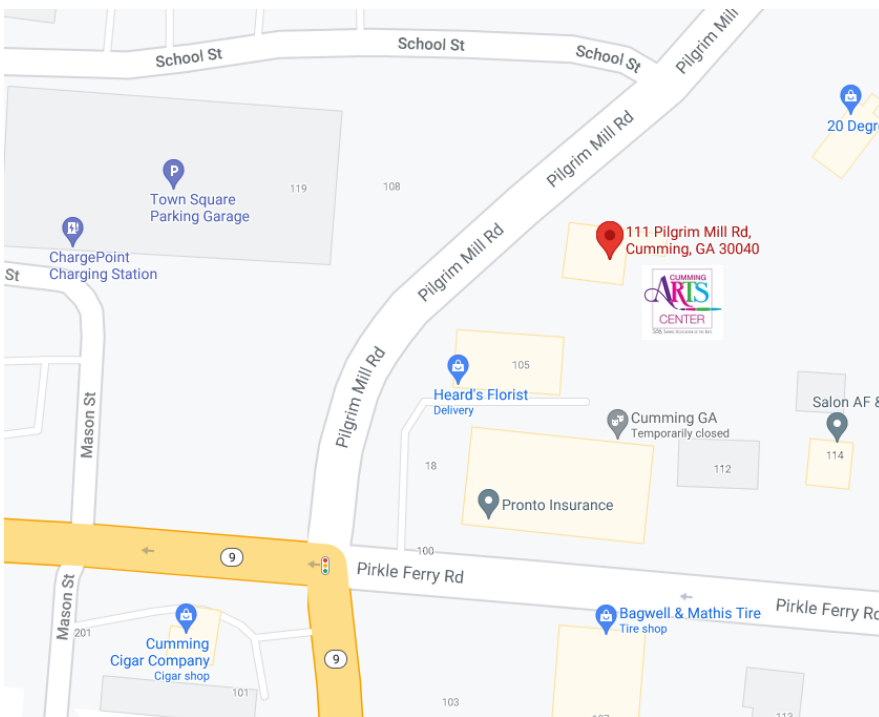


FESTIVAL GUIDELINES:

- The hours of the event are 10:00AM until 4:00PM on Saturday, September 9th. All vendor booths must be functioning no later than 9:45 AM.
- This is a show with a limited number of outdoor booths. Outdoor booth spaces will allow tents.
- Outdoor booths will operate rain or shine, no refunds due to bad weather.
- Display items, shelving, curtains, etc. will be allowed but must remain within assigned space.
- All tables and booths must be kept neat and professional at all times.
- Outdoor booth dimensions are 10 x 10 for art/craft/food vendors, with additional spaces for food truck vendors.
- Vendors will be responsible to bring their own tables and chairs and equipment.
- Electricity is not available. Vendors may bring their own generators, if needed.
- Vendors must not exceed their booth space. If you set up outside of your designated booth area (this includes sitting outside booth space), you will be asked and expected to move to within your booth boundaries. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please be considerate of your neighbors. **Vendors are not allowed to sell outside assigned booth area.**
- This is an invitational, family-oriented festival. Sawnee Association of the Arts reserves the right to remove any inappropriate items.
- To ensure quality of the show and greater sales opportunities for artists and craftsmen, as well as greater variety for the customer, the committee will limit the number of vendors accepted in each cultural category.
- **Vendors are not permitted to break down until 4:00 PM on Saturday, September 9th. NO EXCEPTIONS. Any vendor not abiding by this rule will not be allowed to return to future events.**
- All vendors will be responsible for keeping their space clean from excessive glitter, saw dust, litter, etc. All vendors will be responsible for cleaning up their booth space before leaving.
- All vendors are solely responsible for collecting and remitting 7% sales tax to the State of Georgia. If you have one, it is recommended that you bring your sales tax permit with you to show if requested by county or state inspectors.
- All vendors must submit a list of the types of items or art that will be sold and/or demonstrated in their booth/tent. These items will be reviewed by the Festival committee to ensure that they are appropriate for the Festival theme. No religious pamphlets will be allowed.
